### Event Bag Policy & Prohibited Items

We encourage you to minimize personal belongings you bring to your shift. Bag check will not be available, and any belongings must be kept near your volunteer station during your shift.

#### Screening

All guests will be subject to a search of their person and possessions prior to entering Allianz Field. Guests should be prepared to open their bags to be inspected upon direction by security staff. Guests may be asked to move/remove items from their bags in order to complete a full inspection. **All bags brought into event space must be compliant with the bag size of 12x12x6.** *Diaper and medical bags are allowed with no restrictions; bags will be checked and tagged upon entry.*

#### Items allowed into the event

Small bag or purse, 12" x 12" x 6" only. Does not have to be clear. Medical or diaper bags can exceed that size.

Strollers

Small or disposable cameras

Empty water bottle (plastic; no metal or glass)

#### Prohibited Items

Folding chairs

Aerosol cans

Alcohol

Animals (except service animals)

Balls (beach balls, footballs, baseballs, etc.)

Banners

Camcorders, tripods, and cameras with lenses over six inches long (unless approved previously by stadium staff; must bring written approval to entry)

Coolers of any kind, including small soft pack coolers

Fireworks

Outside Food & Beverage

Illegal drugs

Laptops, iPads, tablets or other large electronic devices

Laser pointers

Markers (permanent) and/or paint

Noisemaking devices

Objects that can be used as projectiles (sticks, bats, clubs, poles, frisbees, etc.)

Weapons

Glass-ware

Using or possessing chalk or paint (including spray paint)

Any items that Allianz Field security or MNUFC deems a risk to the safety of guests are prohibited
